The Halifax Region Children's Aid Foundation provides post-secondary tuition support bursaries primarily to **youth formerly in the care and custody** of the Province of Nova Scotia. Depending on funding availability, bursaries may cover up to the full cost of tuition for successful applicants. Bursaries are awarded in June and December.
